Stunning Southport

Set on the shore of the beautiful Sefton coast, Southport is (in our humble opinion) one of England's best coastal towns. Thankfully, this hidden gem doesn't draw the crowds of neighbouring Blackpool or busy Brighton, so it's long sandy beaches and 19th Century architecture remain blissfully unspoilt.

Town History

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The town of Southport dates back to the late 18th century, when sea bathing became popular along the Lancashire coast. However, a policy brought in during the 1840's was the real turning point for this town, as it encouraged developments which would turn the town into a seaside resort for the 'refined' and 'well to do'. We only choose the very best settings for our Revitalise centres!

Ever since the 19th century Southport has been a well established high-class resort, with multiple hotels, restaurants, shops and gardens to complement its naturally scenic shores.

Marine Lake

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Our Sandpipers centre overlooks the town's large Marine Lake, which is nestled between the town centre and the beach. This man-made lake has long been a popular hang out for locals and wildlife alike, so from the Sandpipers garden you might spot swans gliding across the water as well as families playing on rowing boats and pedalos. Cutting across the width of the lake is the striking Marine Way Bridge, which is one of the town's most iconic sights.

Sandpipers Southport

Sitting pretty on the shores of Southport's Marine Lake, Sandpipers provides stunning panoramic views from it's bright and airy lounge area. Spend your break here relaxing, snapping photographs of the idyllic sunsets and chatting with other guests over dinner or a game or two. Our holidays are usually pretty action packed. We have themed weeks running throughout the year with a variety of activities and excursions on offer at our three centres.

Music lovers can join us for karaoke nights while history buffs might prefer to enjoy a day at one of the country's finest stately homes.

For younger guests we have dedicated youth weeks, for those with Alzheimer's or dementia there are our special 'Treasured Moments' weeks, and for superactive guests we can even organise things like indoor sky diving and sailing.

Care at our Centres

With nearly 60 years' experience providing expert care, we can cater for almost every type of disability or impairment.

We understand that everybody's care needs are different, so when you make a booking, we ask a series of questions to get an overview of your medical conditions and establish which Care Support Package suits you. Before your break, our nurses will phone to go through pre-assessment questions, identifying your exact needs and addressing any concerns. In most cases, carers and accompanying adults do not require a care support package, but please let our assessment team know if this is required. We offer 24 hour on-call nursing and personal care, with fully qualified staff available on request all day, every day - so you can simply relax and enjoy a worry-free break.

Our Care Support Packages

Care Support Package 1

No specific care needs, but the reassurance of knowing our Care Team is on hand should you need them.

Care Support Package 2

Package 1 reassurance, plus personal care support.

Care Support Package 3

Including Package 1 & 2, plus:

- > Support with a hoist

- Stoma management

Each week, Revitalise Sandpipers welcomes so many people through their doors, and we thought it might be nice to hear what they had to say. One guest, Leon, got in touch to discuss an urgent respite break.

Leon stayed at Revitalise Sandpipers during the first national lockdown, travelling all the way from Southampton for much-needed time away from home. Living with his family, day to day life can be both easy and hard at times for Leon, with worries that he is always under his family's feet. Leon's mother is also a frontline health worker, so there were concerns that Coronavirus could be brought into his family home. During his stay at Sandpipers, Leon said,

"It has reduced my stress levels from 100 to 20. If it wasn't for Sandpipers, I don't know what I would do. I just can't thank the staff and Revitalise enough – the organisation, the whole kit and kaboodle for giving me the opportunity to be here. Some days I'm having a really bad day, then you guys pick me up and make me feel better again by saying look its okay to be frustrated and angry."
